Just doubleclick and they play. This is the most popular format.

on USB stick → **1B**

Sync transcript to video for Trial Presentation software or captions

(extra charges will apply)

- **Type 1** : Video + sync files for the **most popular** trial presentation software

- ✓ Sanction (.MDB)
- ✓ Trial Director (.CMS)
- ✓ Summation (.SBF)
- ✓ Trial Pad (.XMEF)
- ✓ LiveNote (.LEF, .PTF)

on DVD-R → **2A**
on USB stick → **2B**

- **Type 2** : **Visionary** (.VDF)

on DVD-R → **2D**

Section 3 – MPEG-4 / High Def

Use [VLC](#) if default player can't play them

MP4 files :

- ✓ Act like MPEG-1 files – doubleclicking should launch them immediately
- ✓ Have better video quality than other formats
- ✓ Take up less space because of better compression
- ✓ Transfer faster over internet because of smaller sizes
- ✓ Use less CPU power when playing because video chipsets assist decoding
- ✓ Play smoother on phones, tablets, and laptops
- ✓ Can be High Definition when depo is shot in HD masters
- ✓ Can be used in many trial presentation softwares, such as Trial Pad
- ✓ Available file types include MP4, MKV, MOV, AVI, whatever you prefer

on DVD-R → **3A**
on USB stick → **3B**
by WeTransfer → **3C**

Section 4 – DVD / MPEG-2

- DVD with menus, like a Redbox DVD, plays on courtroom DVD player

on DVD-R → **4A**

- MPEG-2 files with .MPG extension, should launch with a simple doubleclick

on DVD-R → **4B**
on USB stick → **4C**
